Applicable portions of WES Constitution

Article I – MISSION

Section 2A. Support and enhance participation among individuals involved in the engineering and surveying professions in the State of Wyoming.

Article II – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The Society shall consist of Members, Honorary Members, and Student Members.

Section 2. Membership in the Society is open to all who have an appreciation for and are supportive of the engineering and/or surveying profession(s).

Section 3. Student membership in the society is open to all who are actively pursuing a higher education degree.

Section 4. Anyone wishing to become a Member or a Student Member shall complete and submit an Application for Membership to the Executive Director of the Society. The Application for Membership shall be accompanied by dues for one year.

Section 5. When a Student Member has completed their degree at a college or university, they shall notify the Executive Director and they will be changed to Member status.

Article III – DUES

Section 1. The dues shall be set by a vote of the membership convened at the Annual Meeting. Dues are to be paid annually with membership being granted for the calendar year within which the annual meeting was held. Any member whose dues are delinquent for two years shall be removed from the membership. Reinstatement of membership shall be accompanied by an application per Article II Section 4.
